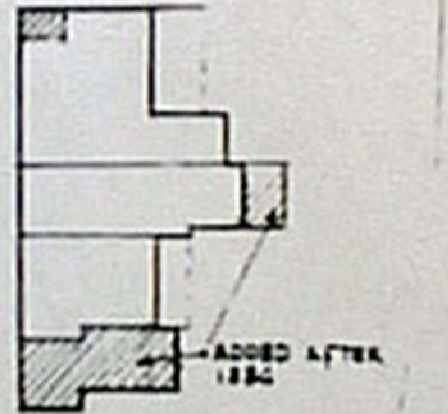
1885 - SANBORN FIRE MAP

An artist's concept of the Royal Presidio of Tucson

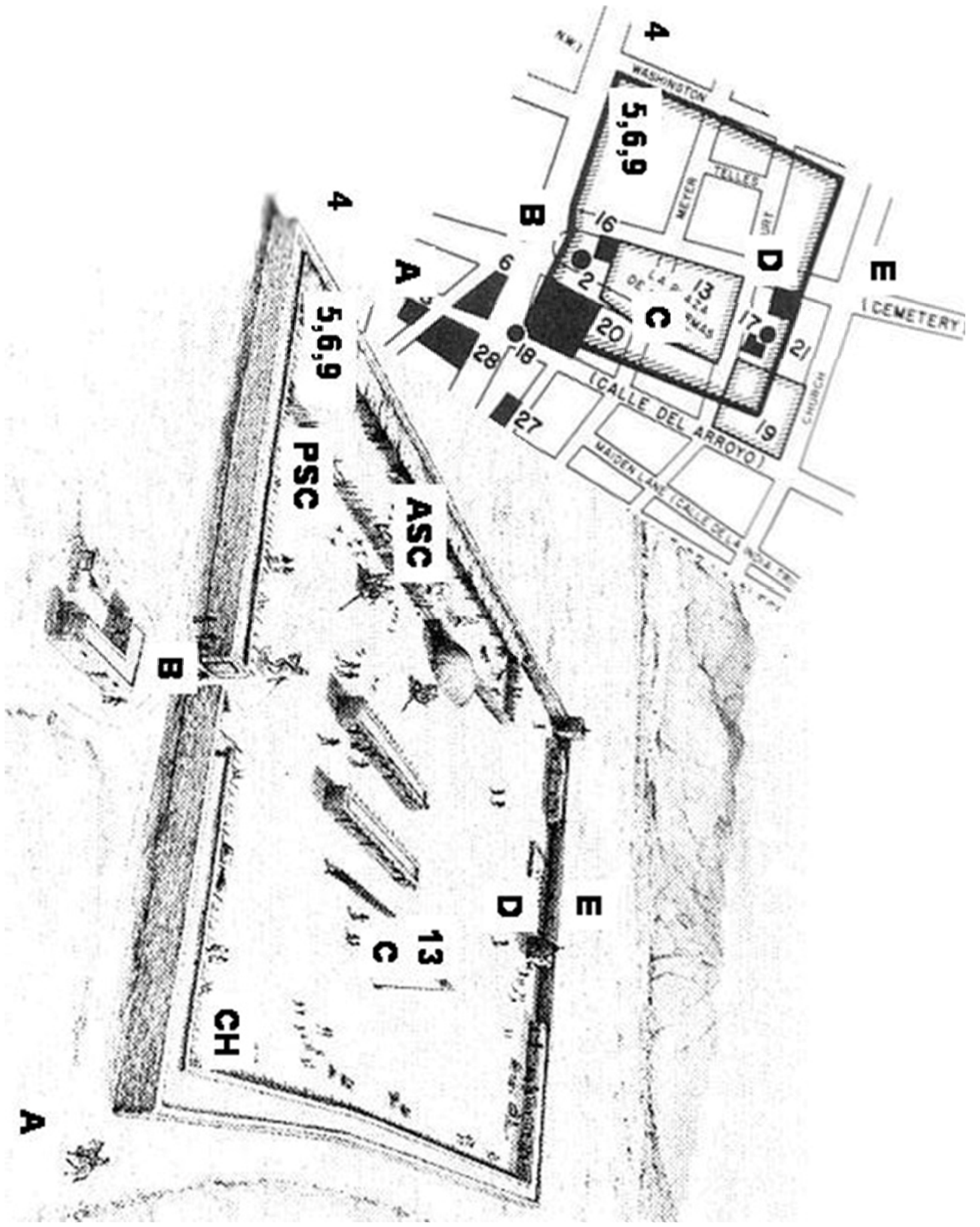

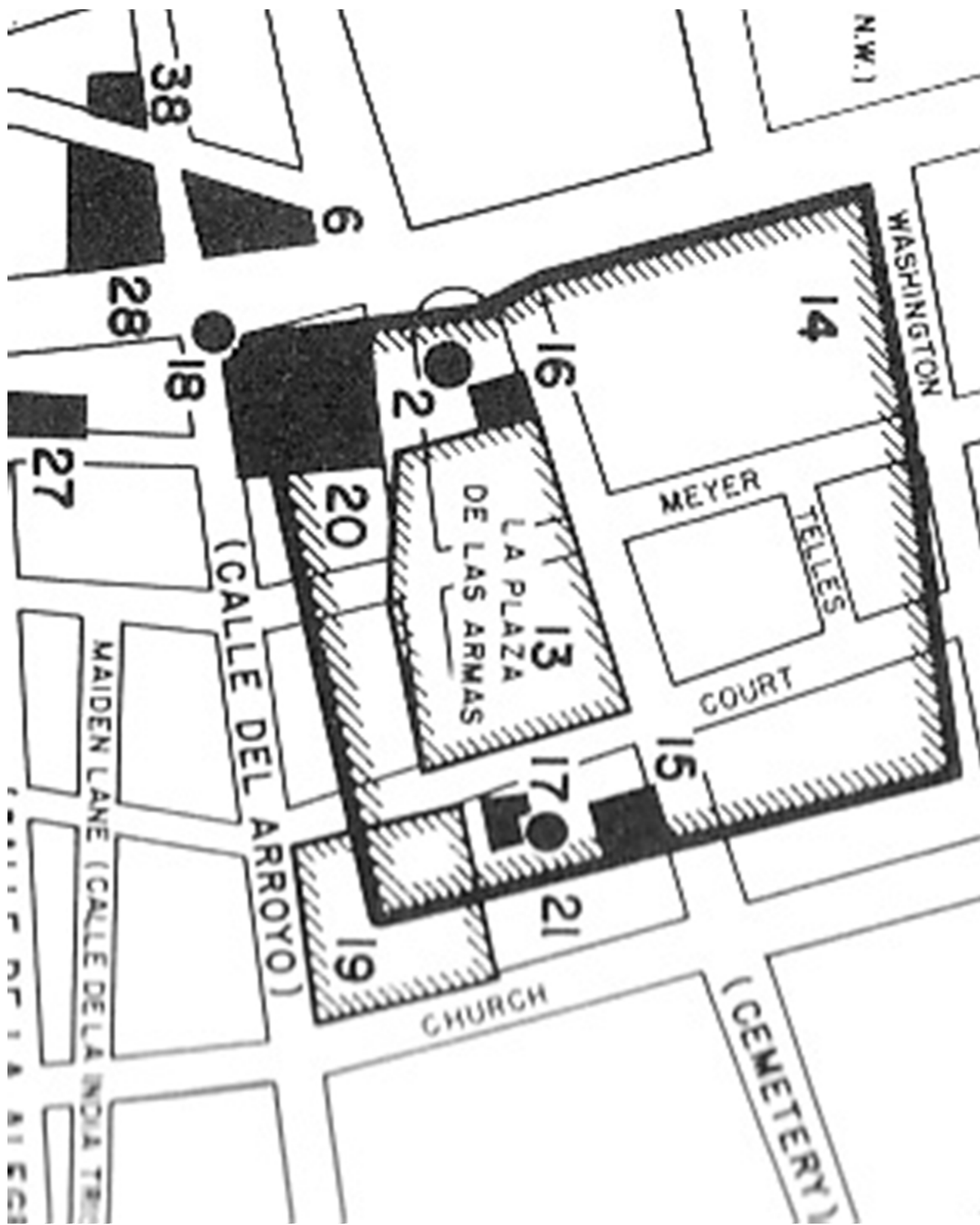

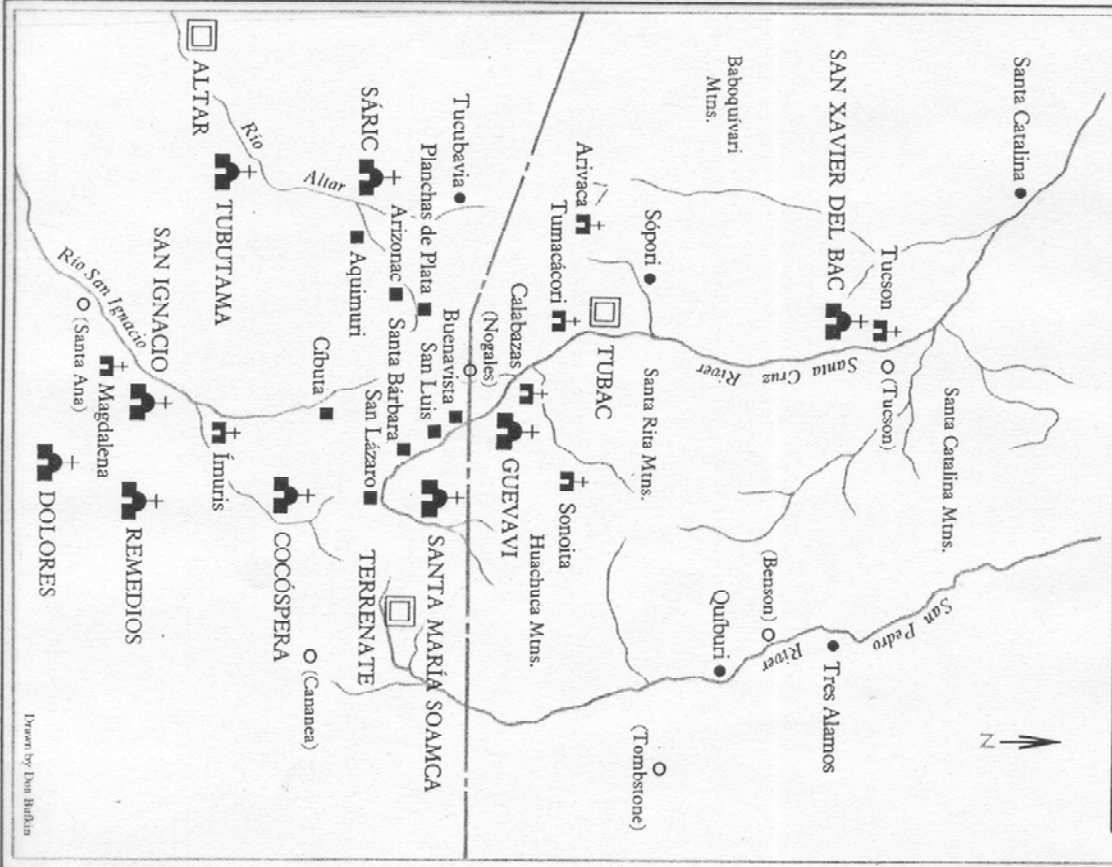


The Northern Pimería Alta, 1691 - 1767

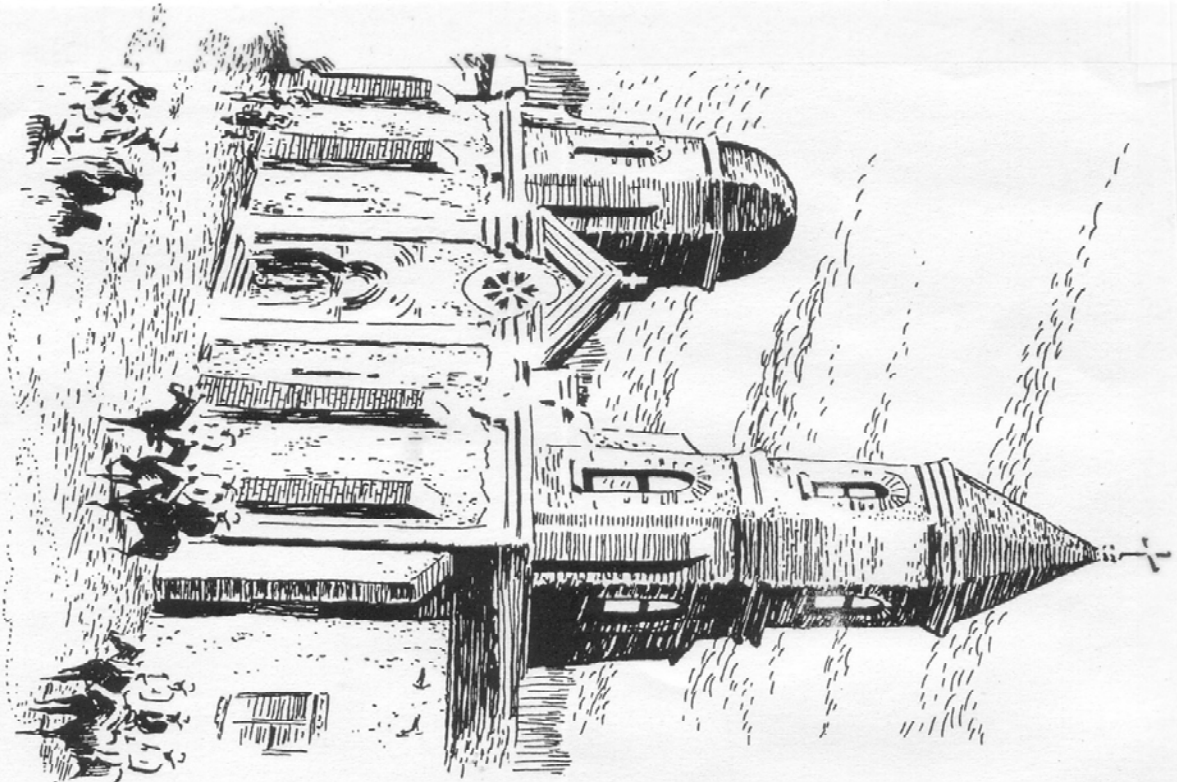

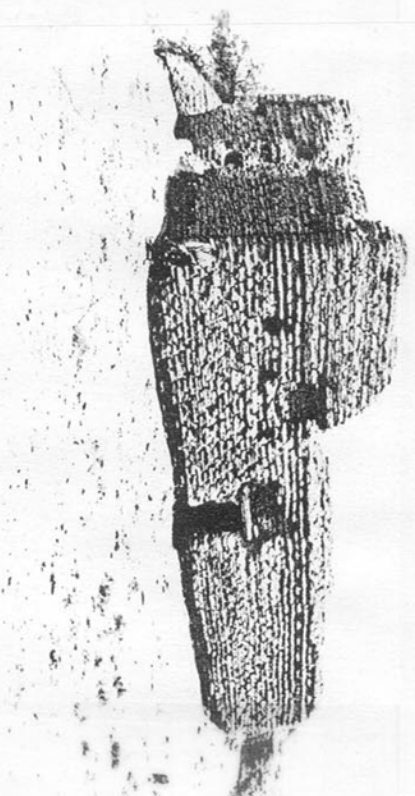
J. Ross Browne, *A Tour Through Arizona*, 1864
 Tubac was the center of civilization in Arizona during the late 1850s but was abandoned to the Apaches by the time Browne visited there in 1864 and sketched this picture.



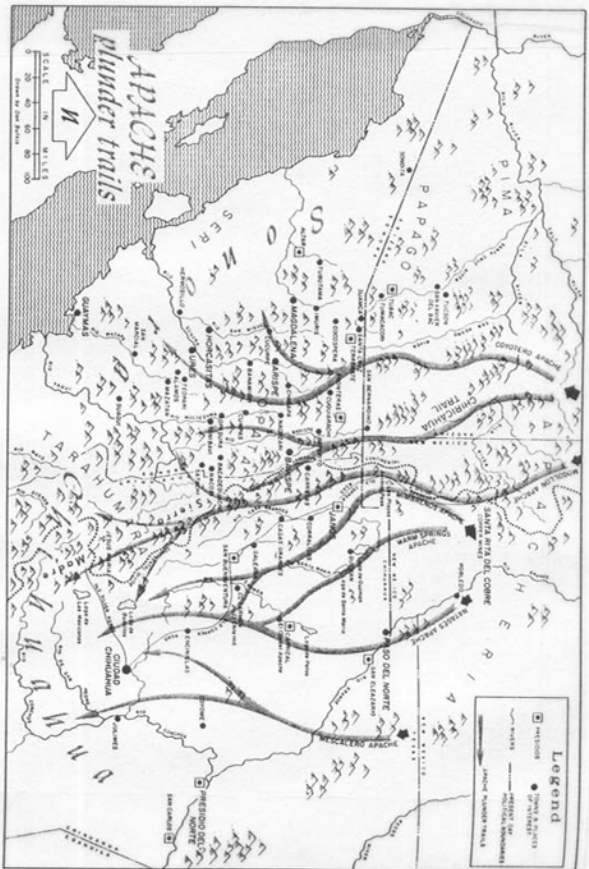
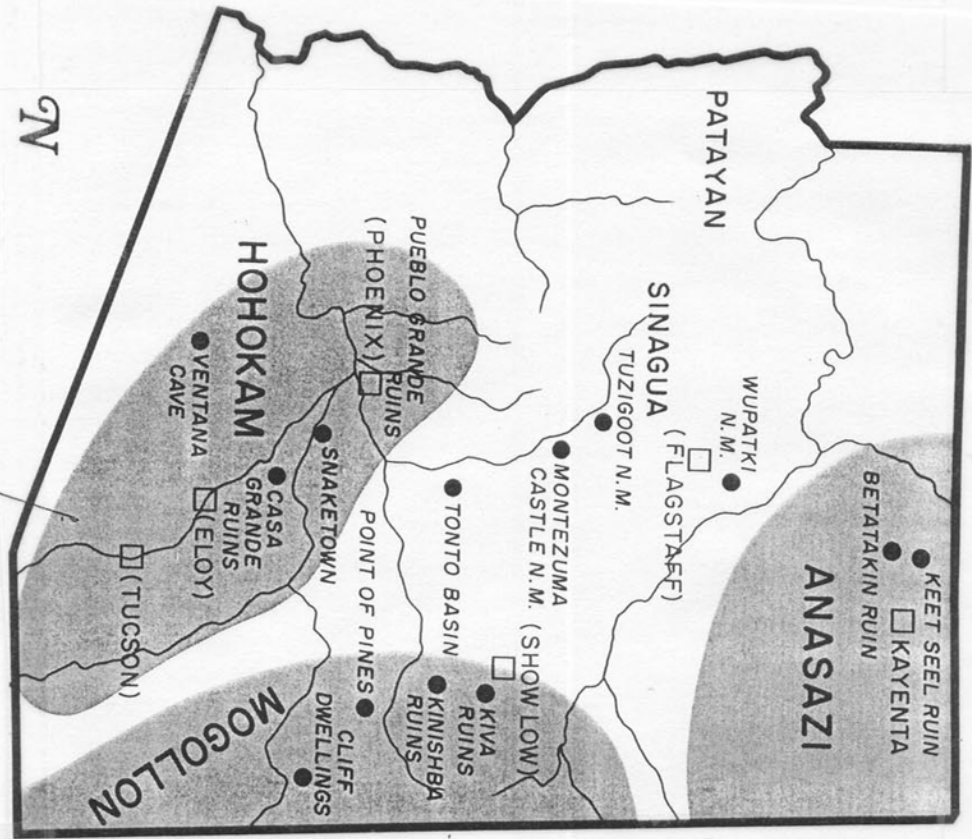
